#### NATIONAL DAY FOR YOUTH IN CLIMATE ACTION

The National Youth Commission (NYC) with its institutional partners, the Climate Change Commission (CCC), YesPinoy Foundation (YPF) Inc. and the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF), will spearhead the observance of the *National Day for Youth in Climate Action* with the theme *#NowPH: Young Artists for Climate Action* on November 25, 2016. This is pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 1160 dated November 12, 2015.

The Celebration aims to:

1. convey the importance of urgent action on climate change impact;  
and
2. promote the youth's creativity, and music and arts as means to communicate to young people the growing concerns on the climate dilemma.

In support of the #NowPH Day, Science teachers are requested to allot time to discuss climate change and the Paris Agreement during the classes on November 25, 2016. Similarly, the members and organizers of the Youth for Environment in Schools Organization (Yes-O) are encouraged to organize climate change-related activities in their respective schools.
