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FIRST NATIONAL WORKSHOP ON MULTI-SENSORIAL TEACHING STRATEGIES
FOR REGULAR STUDENTS AND CHILDREN WITH LEARNING DISABILITIES
AND SPECIAL NEEDS OF THE CHILDREN AND YOUTH WELLNESS
TECHNICAL AND ADVOCACY CENTER (CYWTAC)

The Children and Youth Wellness Technical and Advocacy Center (CYWTAC) Inc. will conduct its *First National Workshop on Multi-Sensorial Teaching Strategies for Regular Students and Children with Learning Disabilities and Special Needs* from April 27 to 29, 2016 at the Skylight Convention Center, Roxas St., Puerto Princesa City, Palawan.

The Workshop aims to:

- a. train the participants on the different multi-sensorial strategies which may be used to address the diverse needs of students in their classrooms;
- b. enhance their teaching internal tools and develop local support systems for students with specialized learning requirements; and
- b. provide the teachers and other educators with resources, guidance, and support to enrich the learning of all students.

The target participants are SPED teachers, special educators, department heads, administrators, counselors, supervisors, consultants and education university students from both public and private schools.

Participation of both public and private schools shall be subject to the *no-disruption-of-classes policy* stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*.
