IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CY 2006 PRINCIPAL-LED SCHOOLBUILDING PROGRAM

TO: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
All others concerned

- 1. Cognizant of the significant contributions of the School Heads/Principals and in order to support the Principal Empowerment Program, the Schools First Initiative and the decentralization policy of the Department, the Physical Facilities and Schools Engineering Division (PFSED) will implement the Schoolbuilding Program for CY 2006 following the Principal-led scheme.
- 2. The Principal-Led Schoolbuilding Program (PL-SBP) scheme is one of the innovations introduced by the Department under the Social Expenditure Management Project (SEMP) funded by the World Bank and was implemented by the Physical Facilities and Schools Engineering Division (PFSED) and the Third Elementary Education Project (TEEP) with the end in view of strengthening school-based management and encourage the participation of the community and technical assistance from professional engineers through the decentralized construction of schoolbuildings.
- 3. The PL-SBP is also in line with the National Program Support for Basic Education (NPSBE) Project which will be funded by the World Bank to assist the Department in the implementation of the Basic Education Sector Reform Agenda (BESRA) supporting its sub-component to develop the capacity of school heads to operate effectively in a decentralized and self-managing school environment. In view of this, the procurement guidelines of the World Bank will be followed in the implementation of this program.
- 4. The PFSED will conduct Orientation Seminar-Workshops in four (4) venues to orient the participants on the implementation scheme of the CY 2006 Principal-Led Schoolbuilding Program (PL-SBP) through lectures/discussions on the following:

- a. Orientation on the Principal-Led Implementation Scheme;
- b. Consultation and finalization of the proposed program of works;
- c. Procurement and contract monitoring procedures;
- d. Strategic and Detailed Implementation Planning
- e. Acceptance and Maintenance of completed projects.
- 5. Target participants to the orientation seminar-workshops are the Regional Directors, Schools Division Superintendents, Principals/School Heads of the recipient schools of the initial release of P500M for the Red and Black schools for CY 2006, Regional/Division Physical Facilities Coordinators, Regional/Division Accountants and PFSED Central Office staff.
