TURN-OVER OF MANAGEMENT OF THE CERTIFICATE PROGRAM FOR NON SPECIALIST HIGH SCHOOL TEACHERS IN SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS

Heads, Public Secondary Schools

- 1. The Certificate Program for non-specialist high school teachers in Science and Mathematics is a 2-summer, 24-units program conducted in collaboration with the Regional Science Teaching Centers (RSTCs) and selected Centers of Excellence (COEs) in teacher education.
- 2. The main objective of the Program is to update the competencies of science and mathematics teachers who are non specialists in the subjects. The list of participants is provided the RSTC or COE by the regional office. Each participant receives a stipend of PhP12,000 and book allowance of PhP2,500. A training fee of PhP8,000 per participant is also paid to the training institution.
- 3. For the purpose of program modeling, the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) in coordination with the Regional Offices (RO) through the Secondary Education Divisions (SED) managed the implementation of Term 1 of Batches 1 and 2 of the Program. For continuing efficiency of Program implementation, earlier release of funds and closer monitoring and evaluation of the program, Program management shall be transferred to the Regions.
- 4. Beginning Summer 2007, the Regions through the Regional Director (RD) shall prepare the Supplementary MOA for the conduct of Term 2 of Batches 1 and 2. The Central Office shall transfer the funds to the Regional Offices upon receipt of a copy of the perfected MOA which shall in turn—be forwarded to the RSTCs/COEs concerned.
- 5. The Regional Office shall coordinate with the RSTCs/COEs relative to Program implementation. The BSE shall transfer all documents pertinent to Program implementation to the Regional Office.
- Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired.
