





PHILIPPINE MILITARY ACADEMY (PMA) SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

To: Bureau Directors

1. The Philippine Military Academy (PMA), the premiere military institution of the land, is announcing the conduct of its annual PMA Entrance Examination (PMAEE) on August 29, 2010 at the different examination centers nationwide.
2. The PMA is offering full tertiary scholarship to deserving Filipino youth who desire to serve the country through the military profession. As full government scholars, the PMA cadets enjoy a well-rounded quality education and receive salary and allowances while studying. After graduation, the PMAers are guaranteed with jobs and are commissioned as regular officers in the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP).
3. To become a PMA Cadet, the applicant must possess the following requirements:
 - a. natural born Filipino citizen;
 - b. physically fit and of good moral character;
 - c. single and have never been married;
 - d. minimum height requirement – 5'4" if male; 5'2" if female (not to exceed 6'4" for both);
 - e. at least high school graduate with a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 85% or higher (for 4th year high school students, 3rd year GPA of 85% or higher); and
 - f. at least 17 years old but not a day older than 22 years old on April 1 of the year following the date of the examination taken (born on or after April 1, 1989 and on or before April 1, 1994).

Applicants may apply on-line at <http://www.pma.ph> or must accomplish the PMA application form (copy enclosed) and submit not later than August 15, 2010, (two (2) weeks before the examination day) to the Office of Cadet Admission, PMA, Fort del Pilar, Baguio City at telephone no.: (074) 446-8002; trunk lines: (074) 447-3690 local 6751 or 6752; mobile phone nos.: 0927-3810-493 or 0918-5872-384.
