2017 CAGAYAN VALLEY REGIONAL ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION MEET

1. The 2017 Cagayan Valley Regional Athletic Association Meet with the theme, "Strengthening Partnerships through Sports", will be held from February 23 to 28, 2017 at the City of Ilagan Sports Complex, City of Ilagan to be hosted by the City Government of Ilagan and the Division Office of the City of Ilagan.

The DepEd division offices shall organize their respective athletic delegations comprising of the

best qualified athletes, coaches and officials.

3. Billiards, Boxing, Futsal, Wrestling and Wushu are now regular sports. Search for Mr. and Ms. CAVRAA and Dance Sports are special events added in this year's activities. Medals earned in Dance Sports shall be added to the general championship medal tally. Sepak Takraw Girls and Special Games for PWD's shall remain to be demonstration sports

4. Only winnable teams and athletes shall be selected to compose the CAVRAA delegation to the

2017 Palarong Pambansa.

5. All technical officials shall attend the scheduled accreditation/refresher course on February 20-22, 2017. They shall report for registration on February 20 at identified quarters by event. Coaches shall attend the refresher course on February 21, 2017.

6. Coaches, chaperons, trainers, technical officials and camp officials who will serve in the 2017 CAVRAA Meet shall be granted *vacation service credits pursuant to the provision of DepED Order No. 53, s. 2003 entitled, "Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers."*

7. Eco-Friendliest Delegation shall be evaluated by invited external partners.

2017 CAVRAA

GENERAL GUIDELINES AND INFORMATION

- 1. The 2017 CAVRAA Meet will officially open on February 23, 2017 at the City of Ilagan Sports Complex. Closing/Awarding will be on February 28, 2017. All athletes, coaches, delegation officials and officiating officials shall attend the opening and closing ceremonies.
- 2. 2017 CAVRAA shall have friendly and safe competitions.
- 3. Guidelines in the screening and accreditation of athletes and coaches must be strictly implemented. Questions on eligibility shall be addressed to the Screening and Accreditation Committee.
- 4. All sports competitions shall be conducted in accordance with the international rules and regulations. However, ground rules shall be prescribed if and when necessitated by local conditions, provided that they are agreed upon by the coaches of the teams and the technical officials concerned.
- 5. Protests on technicalities shall be addressed to the Tournament Managers who shall resolve the issue in their own level within 2 hours upon receipt of the written protest.
- 6. Accredited officiating officials from private and public schools shall be authorized to officiate as long as they meet the requirements.
- 7. Medical teams shall be provided by the host and participating delegations. No matches will be played without official doctors especially in combative events. Participating delegations shall ensure the fitness of the players to play.
- 8. Seeding shall be done except when there's a new set of competing teams. Pairing is determined by drawing of lots.
- 9. The law of succession shall be observed in all matches. The Tournament Managers are authorized to declare forfeiture of games based on the law of succession.
- 10. Protested team shall continue to play as scheduled. If any violation is established, the match played by that team shall be declared forfeited in favor of the opposing team. For Individual Events, the points and awards shall be forfeited.
- 11. Only winnable athletes shall be selected for the 2017 Palarong Pambansa. Due to budgetary constraints, composition of team events will be trimmed down.
- 12. Selection of athletes in team events shall be based from "core group". Selection of other athletes to complete the team shall be based from performance and position. For batted games, core group will be 6 and 9 for football except when smaller delegation is required to join the palaro.
- 13. All winning coaches shall be selected for higher competitions. In case this right is waived, "next in rank" is applied.
- 14. All selected athletes must pass the Physical Fitness Tests and height and weight requirements for palaro. Failure to pass the tests is a ground for disqualification.
- 15. Winners in the individual events shall be selected automatically. However, Individual winners in athletics, archery and swimming shall meet a qualifying time/distance (6th placer in the previous Palaro) in order to be qualified for the 2017 Palarong Pambansa.
