## LINANGAN: PAGLALANG NG MUNDONG LIGTAS, MAPANG-AKAP AT MAPADAYON SA PAMAMARAANG ANTROPOLOHIKAL NG UNIBERSIDAD NG PILIPINAS

The University of the Philippines (UP) Department of Anthropology will hold its online "Linangan: Paglalang ng Mundong Ligtas, Mapang-akap at Mapadayon sa Pamamaraang Antropolohikal (Linangan: Creating Safe, Compassionate and Sustainable Worlds with Anthropology)", a series of teaching modules for teachers in senior high schools and higher educational institutions, as well as practitioners in governance, heritage work, social work and other relevant applied fields on November 20 and 27, 2021.

Linangan is composed of seven modules, which promote the multidisciplinary anthropology and explore its applications in generating safe, inclusive, and sustainable worlds. These modules aim to address contemporary issues relating to cultural preservation, heritage, human rights, gender and sexuality, environmental sustainability, and other related issues, that could be used in the instruction of senior high school and tertiary level courses and for generating programs and policies that are sensitive and responsive to the needs and sensibilities of different stakeholders.

## Specifically, *Linangan* intends to:

- 1. Provide educators with instructional tools and materials for teaching courses on society, culture and the environment, that demonstrate critical and reflexive approaches in understanding social difference, human agency, and the politics of culture-making;
- 2. Offer new or alternative ways of conducting and implementing community-based programs towards the preservation and promotion of community heritage, social equality/equity, social justice, human security, safe spaces, and environmental sustainability, that are attuned to the views and needs of the different members of (their own) communities; and
- 3. Provide participants with professional credentials by acquiring CPD points for each module attended.

This activity is part of the UP College of Social Sciences and Philosophy's Professional Education Series (PROFESS), designed for teachers and professionals in relevant fields to learn and update their knowledge on theories and methodologies in social sciences and philosophy that they can use in instruction and their applied work.
