xxx In case of foreign bidders, a Certificate of Authentication from the Department of Foreign Affairs shall be required for document submitted, i.e. the Class "A" documents or its equivalent that are written in foreign language, translated to English, and duly authenticated by the appropriate Philippine foreign service establishment/post or the equivalent office having jurisdiction over the foreign bidder's affairs in the Philippines. XXX

Provision as Amended

If the eligibility requirements or statements, the bids, and all other documents for submission to the BAC are in foreign language other than English, it must be accompanied by a translation in English, which shall be authenticated by the appropriate Philippine foreign service establishment, post, or the equivalent office having jurisdiction over the foreign bidder's affairs in Philippines. Similar to required authentication above, for Contracting Parties to the Apostille Convention, only the translated documents shall be authenticated through apostille pursuant to **GPPB** Resolution No. 13-2019 dated 23 2019. The May English translation shall govern, for purposes of interpretation of the bid.

Submission of Samples:

In addition to the documentary requirements to be submitted during post-qualification as provided under ITB Clause 20.1, the bidder/s having the Lowest Calculated Bid/s shall submit ONE sample for each item.

However, the bidder may provide a sample of better or superior quality, which, if accepted, shall be the reference for award, contract, prospection, and eventual delivery.

These samples shall be subjected to evaluation during post-qualification. The Technical Working Group (TWG) shall evaluate the said samples to determine compliance with the required technical specifications subject to the approval of the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC).

These samples should not be part of the units to be delivered.

Submission of Samples:

In addition to the documentary requirements to be submitted during the <u>Opening of Bids</u>, as provided, the bidder/s shall submit at least two (2) samples for each item, regardless of the number of lots bid for.

However, if bidder has different sets of samples, the bidder may indicate as to what particular lot the samples are being referred/applied to, otherwise, the samples submitted shall be construed to apply to all lots being bid by the bidder.

These samples shall be subjected to evaluation during *Bid evaluation*. The Technical Working Group (TWG) shall evaluate the said samples to determine compliance with the required technical specifications subject to the approval of the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC).

ABA – JAD – KY - SA Page 6 of 9 Failure of the samples to meet DepEd technical specifications shall be a ground for disqualification of the bidder/s.

These samples should not be part of the units to be delivered.

Failure of all the samples to meet the DepEd technical specifications shall be a ground for disqualification of the bidder/s. At least 1 complete set/package consisting of the 9 items submitted should be compliant with the specifications to qualify.


