The activities and competitions that will be held for the said event are stated below.

- 1. 35th National Mathematical Challenge (MATHEMATCH)
 - A three-member team quiz contest open to all junior high school and senior high school students nationwide.
- 2. Poster Making Competition
 - An art competition that is open to all junior high school and senior high school students nationwide. This will test the students' creativity through integrating the underlying mathematical science concepts related to this year's theme.
- 3. Teacher's Seminar
 - A seminar for the coaches/teachers of the participating students in the 35th MATHEMATCH and the Poster Making Competition.
- 4. Puzzle of the Day and Puzzle of the Week
 - Week-long puzzles will be posted before and until the celebration week to challenge the minds of the masses.
