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2023 NATIONAL PHYSICAL EDUCATION CONVENTION OF THE 1PHYSED.PH TRAINING AND DEVELOPMENT SERVICES

The 1PhysEd.Ph Training and Development Services will be organizing the 2023 National Physical Education Convention with the theme, Taking the Next Big Leap: Community Synergy for the Future of Philippine Physical Education on December 16–18, 2023 at De La Salle Santiago Zobel School, Muntinlupa City.

This annual convention intends to provide a clear perspective of the vital role of Physical Education teachers in facilitating effective and meaningful sports and PE programs as primary contributors to bringing fitness and wellness to learners. This will help PE teachers as classroom influencers to create and make an impact for students to value their participation in regular physical activities through various mediums. Furthermore, the convention's activities aim to improve PE teachers' competence by providing them with sessions that will address current and relevant issues and concerns in the Philippine Physical Education Community.

A day will be allocated for a workshop training on the K to 10 MATATAG Physical Education and Health Curriculum, Senior High School Health Optimizing Physical Education (H.O.P.E.) Curriculum, Special Program for Sports and Tertiary Service PE Physical Activity Towards Fitness and Health (PATHFIT).

The workshop will provide an opportunity for the participants to strengthen their familiarity and competencies in implementing the curriculum. Lastly, the convention's overall goal is to bring together many teachers, researchers, and scholars to discuss and share their experiences and research-based findings in all areas of Physical Education and Sports. It will also serve as a premier interdisciplinary forum for academics, practitioners, and educators to present and discuss the most recent advances, trends, concerns, practical difficulties encountered, and solutions implemented in interdisciplinary research.
