The Tanghalan Mandaluyong is a non-profit community theater youth organization that has a mission to keep the children and youth away from the streets through the performing arts.

Below is the list of stage plays produced by the organization.

Title of the Play	Description	Proposed Grade Level
<i>Hindi Kasi Ako Tapos</i> (HIKAT)	HIKAT is a play that reminds the youth to value their education. It encourages them to pursue and finish their studies through a story of five former schoolmates who reunite, reminisce, and recalibrate their life narratives.	Grades 6–12
<i>Reyna</i> (<i>Ang Buhay at Pag-Ibig ni Cleopatra</i>)	This play explores the multi-faceted roles of the historical figure Cleopatra, Queen of Egypt, in contrast to her common depiction.	Grades 6–12
<i>Kailan Kaya?</i> The Musical	This is about the crime boss Mang Karding who terrorizes abducted persons into submission to his whims. Expect an unexpected resolution to this plot.	Grades 11–12
Catsville: The Musical	Five Feline Teams fight to win the 9 Nine Lives Amulet, in the annual competition spearheaded by Old Whiskers. In the midst of it all, an orphan cat named Manuel shows up and teaches everyone about the true meaning of love and forgiveness.	Grades 4–7
Romeo and Juliet	A beloved William Shakespeare classic about two houses in perennial conflict. Finally, prime children from the mortal foes get to meet each other, by fateful circumstances. Romeo Montague and Juliet Capulet fall in love; and in so doing, this alters the destiny of their fair Verona.	Grades 8–12
Manda at Luyong	This is a re-telling of the folkloric history of the beginnings of what is today Mandaluyong City. Reminiscent of the nation's other ancient tales, it narrates perseverance through a series of trials, in the quest for love; imbued with an unashamed spirit of love for homeland and Mother Nature.	Grades 6–12
