Appeal/Requests	Response
1. Is Contract/Purchase Order (from abroad) attachment as Proof of Selling Abroad needs to be Apostilled?	Please refer to ITB Clause 10.3 of the Bidding Documents which states that: If the eligibility requirements or statements, the bids, and all other documents for submission to the BAC are in foreign language other than English, it must be accompanied by a translation in English, which shall be authenticated by the appropriate Philippine foreign service establishment, post, or the equivalent office having jurisdiction over the foreign bidder's affairs in the Philippines. Similar to the required authentication above, for Contracting Parties to the Apostille Convention, only the translated documents shall be authenticated through an apostille pursuant to GPPB Resolution No. 13-2019 dated 23 May 2019. The English translation shall govern, for purposes of interpretation of the bid.
2. Is Contract/Purchase Order (from abroad) attachment of SLCC needs to be Apostilled?	
3. Is Contract/Purchase Order (from Abroad) attachment of On-Going contracts needs to be Apostilled?	
4. Does Manufacturer's Certificate need to be Apostilled?	

All other provisions not herein modified shall remain in full force and effect.
